ORDINANCE NO. IV
CONWAY TOWNSHIP
LIVINGSTON COUNTY MICHIGAN
FIRE ORDINANCE

The Township of Conway, Livingston County, Michigan Hereby Ordains:

SECTION I. Be it resolved that the Conway Township Board of Trustees impose a collection fee of the previous year's average billing of fire runs, for services rendered to non-residents/non-property owners of the Fowlerville Fire District for emergencies involving motorized vehicles, which fee is for the purpose of defraying the cost of purchasing, housing equipment and for the operation of equipment.

SECTION II. Be it resolved by the Conway Township Board of Trustees that any resident and or property owner must obtain a burning permit from an authorized agent of the Fowlerville Fire District before any open burning other than in an approved debris burner or when the ground is snow covered. Also be it resolved by the Conway Township Board of Trustees, to impose a collection fee of the preceding year's average billing of fire runs for emergency services rendered by the Fowlerville Fire District, for any violation of the Conway Township Fire Ordinance.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall take immediate effect, upon publication in a newspaper of general circulation. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

NOW COMES Plaintiff, CONWAY TOWNSHIP, and Defendant, RAYMOND BIRD, by and through their respective counsels, after having appeared in open Court before the Honorable Paul R. Mahinske on July 26, 1982 and hearing having been heard on Plaintiff's Motion and Order to Show Cause and the parties having reached agreement that's provided below after Defendant acknowledged having accumulated various junk automobiles and automobile parts in violation of the Circuit Court Orders entered September 30, 1981 and January 13, 1982, and the Court otherwise being fully informed in the premises;

IT IS ORDERED that the Defendant, RAYMOND BIRD, shall remove on or before August 1, 1982 at midnight, all junk automobiles and automobile parts on or about the premises at 3836 Harrington Road, Webberville, Michigan.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant, RAYMOND BIRD, his agents, heirs and assigns shall not accumulate or allow to be placed on or about the premises located at 3836 Harrington Road, Webberville, Michigan, any junk automobiles or automobile parts and the Defendant, his heirs and assigns are prohibited from operating a junk yard or similiar salvage facility on or about the premises.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Conway Township Supervisor or Clerk shall have the absolute right and authority to enter upon and about the Defendant's premises at 3836 Harrington Road, Webberville, Michigan, to inspect the premises, including the right to take photographs, between the hours of 8:00 a.m and 9:00 p.m., any day of the week to satisfy themselves that the Defendant is complying with the terms and conditions of this Order.

IT IS FURTHERED ORDERED that the Livingston County Sheriff shall arrest the Defendant, RAYMOND BIRD, and bring him before this Honorable Court to Show Cause what reason, if any, he may have for violation of the terms and conditions of this Order if the Township Supervisor or Clerk sign a sworn affidavit and file the same with the Livingston County Sheriff's Department stating specific violations observed on the premises located at 3836 Harrington Road, Webberville, Michigan, or said Livingston County Sheriff shall obtain a bench warrant for the Defendant, RAYMOND BIRD, requiring his presence before the Circuit Judge to Show Cause what reason, if any, he should not be held in contempt of the terms and conditions of this Order.
