Conditions of Approval: Solar energy equipment must be repaired, removed, or replaced within six (6) months of becoming non-functional. All solar energy equipment must conform to County, State, and Federal regulations and safety requirements as well as applicable industry standards. Solar energy collectors and the installation and use thereof shall comply with all applicable construction codes and electrical codes. Solar energy collectors shall be installed, maintained, and used only in accordance with the manufacturer's directions. Solar energy collectors must be permanently and safely attached to the ground. If the solar energy collector system is not in operation for a period of one year or more, the system shall be removed by Applicant or the property owner and the site shall be stabilized and revegetated as necessary to minimize erosion.
